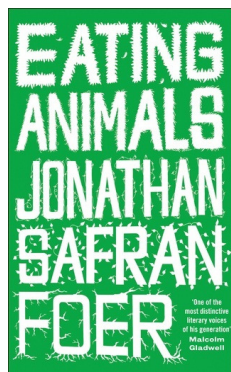

It's tempting to dismiss Jonathan Safran Foer's "Eating Animals" as the product of a cocky, self-involved writer who woke up one day and discovered factory farming. Haven't Michael Pollan, Eric Schlosser et al. been here before? More than 20 years after "60 Minutes" visited a chicken-processing plant, do we need another dive into the "fecal soup" that Diane Sawyer described? The catalyst for Foer's three years of research into what became his first nonfiction book was the impending birth of his son. When presented with the challenge of deciding the diet of his offspring, he wanted answers about meat: "Where does it come from? How is it produced? How are animals treated, and to what extent does that matter?"
