On 11 September 2001 (known as 9/11 in America), Islamist extremists hijacked four planes that were flying above the US. Two of them were flown into the twin towers of the World Trade Center in New York. Another was crashed into the Pentagon, the top military building in the capital city, Washington DC. The fourth plane crashed into a field, 80 miles from Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. US air traffic controllers confirmed a passenger plane, American Airlines Flight 11, had been hijacked. 8.45am US time (1.45pm UK time). Flight 11 crashed into the north tower of the World Trade Center in New York. 9.03am US time (2.03pm UK time). A second hijacked passenger plane, United Airlines Flight 175, crashed into the south tower of the World Trade Center. 9.30am US time (2.30pm UK time).
