Race, Space, and Riots is, according to the author, a sequel to her ambitious study *New York, Chicago, and Los Angeles: America's Global Cities* (1999), published by University of Minnesota Press. In her new book, urban sociologist Janet L. Abu-Lughod focuses more specifically on questions of race and racial violence in the same three cities. Her study asks why race relations in three of the largest U. S. metropolises have developed so differently and seeks answers in the "historical, geographical/spatial, and political characteristics of the cities themselves" (vii). She selects

While space and race marked events in Chicago, class and race seemed to reflect the black-white antagonisms and hostilities in New York.
