3.1.4. Agricultural market reforms The agricultural sector indicator captures intervention in the market for the main agricultural export commodity in each country. It measures the extent of public intervention in the market going from total monopoly or monopsony in production, transportation or marketing (i.e., the presence of marketing boards), the presence of administered prices, public ownership of relevant producers or concession requirement to free market. 30 We also explore whether democracy affects the probability of reversal in reforms (defined as a decrease in the level of index) and do not find any evidence for this hypothesis. 31 For robustness, we also estimate Equation (3) with longer lags; but do not find evidence for any feedback effects (results available on request). 17.
