Archaeology has had a great contribution to the study of post-medieval, industrial and contemporary Britain in its ability to provide answers with hands on visual evidence. Post-Medieval Archaeology. The post-medieval period is generally defined as 1500 - 1800 (Klein, 1992). The industrial revolution of the 19th century, Britain's industrial heritage spans into the modern day - leaving behind archaeological evidence to give insight into the many aspects of industrial activity and the life of the people involved. Young (2014) has noted a pitfall in the role of archaeology in explaining the industry of Britain, continuing to say that it has been far too concerned with the role of machinery and buildings rather than the people involved. Coastal Archaeology of Britain. A The recognition of the wealth and diversity of England's coastal archaeology has been one of the most important developments of recent years. Some elements of this enormous resource have long been known. C The dominant process affecting the physical form of England in the post-glacial period has been rising in the altitude of sea level relative to the land, as the glaciers melted and the landmass readjusted. Most of the known wrecks around our coast are not unexpectedly of post-medieval date, and offer an unparalleled opportunity for research which has yet been little used.
